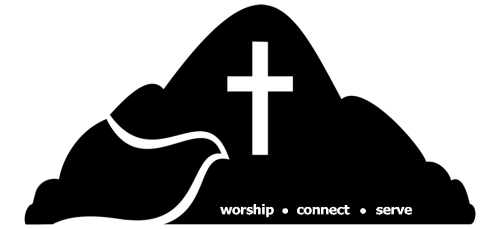

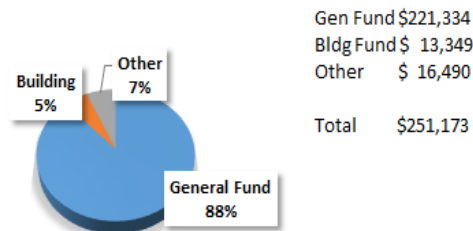
CD copies of weekly sermons are available on the shelves near the library in the Hospitality Center.
