A vehicle you are ready to part with – running or not – can make a significant difference. Hands makes it possible for single women to keep getting to work and provide for their children. Together, we will impact more than 275 women's lives this year.

The car donation process is simple and straightforward:

- ★ Hands will call to schedule pick-up/delivery
- ★ Hands will provide donation documentation (ask about the Colorado Enterprise Zone tax credit)

SPONSOR A CAR

(Providing Hope)

A \$3,500 Car Sponsorship - another great option for companies, civic groups, and small communities to help Hands prepare acquired vehicles for use.

Once a vehicle is donated, important work begins. Unlike other car donation programs that receive cars and send checks to nonprofits, Hands conducts the process "in house."

Sponsorship funds are used to:

- ★ Obtain needed auto parts and supplies for Hands' automotive professionals to ensure cars are safe and reliable for clients
- ★ Update emissions certificate
- ★ Clean and detail the vehicles
- ★ Support the women's vehicle maintenance for a year.

Good Neighbor Garage (GNG) is Hands' unique, multi-faceted program providing practical solutions to an often-overlooked obstacle – unreliable vehicle issues.

GNG PROGRAM COMPONENTS:

VEHICLE PLACEMENT

Through this service, Hands has the ability to place reliable, donated cars with women, who are working or are in school/ job training, whose current vehicles cannot be repaired, or they do not have a car.

REPAIRS

Work is performed by qualified and experienced technicians at Hands' own repair shop, at a GNG partner repair facilities, or by Hands "Pit Crews" (volunteer teams that perform repairs).

MAINTENANCE

Clients are encouraged to schedule follow up visits for a year or two after their initial service to ensure minor concerns do not grow into more costly issues.

Car care education also is woven into each program component, aimed at empowering women to partner in the care of their vehicles. Services may be available for up to two years.

Hands of The Carpenter is a caring community of diverse individuals and organizations dedicated to working together to provide help and HOPE with and for single women in need striving to maintain employment, provide for their families, and stay on the road towards economic self-sufficiency. Since 2003, Hands has served thousands of single women.

The effort began as a church outreach ministry to women struggling to "make it" without the support of a spouse or other family. Hands continues to operate as a "faith-based" nonprofit organization that does not conduct any religious activities and serves women without expectation that they have a particular faith perspective.
