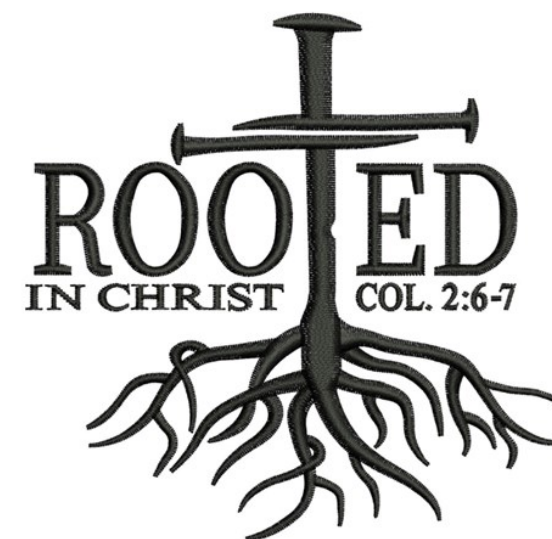

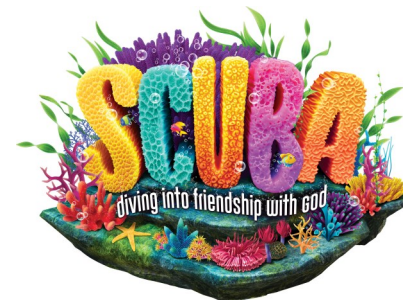


Vacation Bible School: June 10-14 9a—Noon

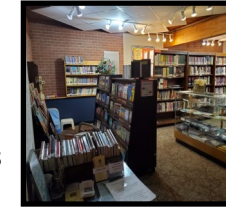

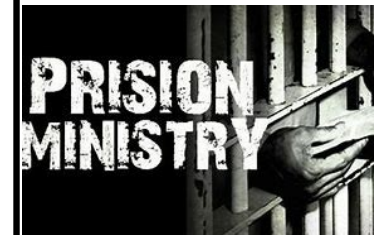
