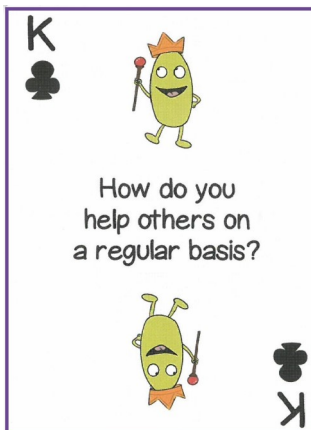
Please remember to keep signing your children in using our KidCheck system which will now be located in the café (by the kitchen).

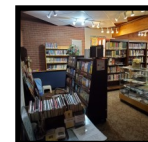
