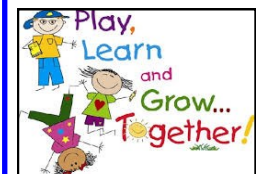

Text the amount you want to give (for ex. 100) to 8447915486, then press send.

2. Register

The first time only you will receive a registration link. Click the link and enter your contact information. You will only have to do this once.

3. Give to First Fruits

repeat step 1: Get Started.

4. To give to a specific fund: Text 'Funds' to the number. Wait for a return text listing the fund choices. Then type in the donation amount, space, then fund name and then press send. (ex. 10 FFruits) (dollar sign not necessary; decimal point accepted)

You will receive a verification text as well as a receipt via email. Donations will also be reflected on the year end statement you receive from Peace.

Repeat the donation process if you want to give to other funds.

For extra ease make this number a contact in your phone Orphan Grain Train Volunteers from Peace and other Lutheran Churches have been sorting and packing boxes of clothing, linens, shoes quilts, etc. December 3rd there were 18 Volunteers from several Lutheran churches loading a semi at Gethsemane Lutheran Church, our local warehouse, with isolation gowns, 336 boxes of clothing, linens, etc, and medical equipment plus 52 preschool cots, a sleeping bag, bicycle, shower seats, crutches, etc. Thank you volunteers and donators.
