In his new book, **Don't Miss the Boat – Facts to Keep Your Faith Afloat**, (220.9 Tay) Paul Taylor looks at the flood of Noah from several standpoints including the Bible, history, and science. He gives many proofs to help build your faith in the Word of God and strengthen readers to defend this truth. Taylor digs deep into Genesis chapter 6-8. Each chapter provides commentary, quoting from many writers such as John Calvin, John Gill, Matthew Henry, John Bunyon, and others. The topics he discusses include the world before the flood, the sons of God and the daughters of men, the flood prophesied, giants, wickedness of men, God's wrath on man's wickedness, what it means to repent and God's grace, the ark, Noah's faith, the flood itself, God's activity during the flood and remembering Noah, the rainbow, God's covenant with Noah, what the world was like after the flood, and more. You'll want to read this text to increase your understanding of this world event and what it means for humanity!
