He referred to Himself as "Son of Man," which is the moniker that God used for Ezekiel; an eccentric, suffering, largely rejected prophet at one of the lowest points in Israel's history. What was so special about Ezekiel, that Jesus would choose to align and identify Himself with this unconventional prophet?

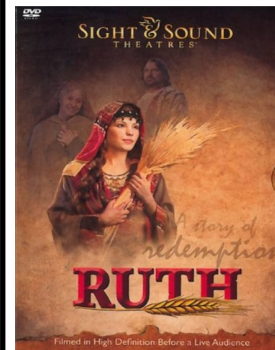
