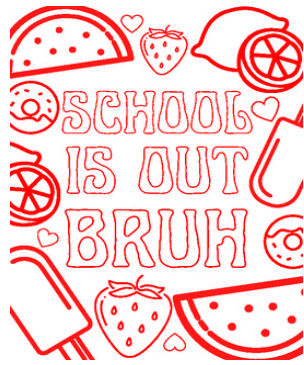

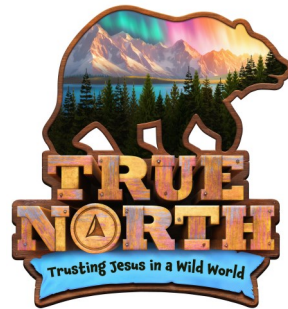

The Gospel authors had a favorite name for Jesus: "Son of David." They associated Jesus with the king who ruled at the height of Israel's greatness as a kingdom and a military power. But Jesus associated Himself with someone else. He referred to Himself as "Son of Man," which is the moniker that God used for Ezekiel; an eccentric, suffering, largely rejected prophet at one of the lowest points in Israel's history. What was so special about Ezekiel, that Jesus would choose to align and identify Himself with this unconventional prophet?

- **Holy Communion:** As Lutheran Christians, we believe, teach and confess that the risen Lord Jesus Christ is actually present in the Sacrament of Holy Communion. He gives us His true body and blood in, with and under the bread and wine for the forgiveness of our sins. This teaching of the real presence of Christ is central to our celebration of this sacrament. Therefore, we practice fellowship or close communion—meaning we believe those approaching the altar should share this core belief. Grape juice is available in the center cup of the tray. Did you realize there is a 400 year time gap between the last book of the Old Testament (Malachi) to the beginning of the Gospel of Matthew in the New Testament? This time period has been sometimes referred to as **The Four Hundred Silent Years** (220.9 Iro). Author H. A. Ironside has referenced sources such as Josephus and the first book of the Maccabees to try to find historical answers about what actually happened to the Jewish nation during this gap. These years were anything but quiet! It was a period of tremendous upheaval both religiously and spiritually. You'll want to read to find out what events fill this time span!
