

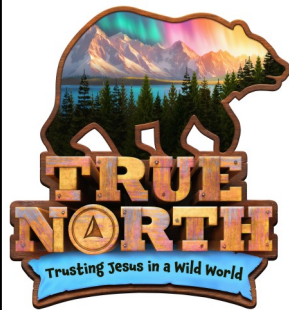

We are excited to share a special opportunity to enhance our outdoor learning environment—and we'd love your support! As some of you know, during the week of spring break, our school experienced unexpected storm damage caused by a **microburst**, a sudden, powerful downdraft of wind that can cause significant localized damage. This particular storm impacted our building's roof and several areas of our outdoor play spaces. We lost several key pieces of equipment—including play cars, play houses, portable slides, and storage units. While we're grateful no one was hurt, the loss emphasized a growing need: a more **permanent and durable play structure** that will better withstand weather and continue to serve children for years to come. We're thrilled to announce that a new permanent structure is now in the works! It will provide a safe, engaging, and welcoming space for our youngest learners to explore and grow through outdoor play. Our goal is to have the installation complete around the time school starts back up in August. This project comes with a total cost of **\$28,351**, and thanks to the incredible generosity of our church community, we've already raised **\$19,700** toward that goal. A deposit has been made, and we're eager to bring this vision to life—with your help. If you're in a position to contribute—or if you know of a business or organization that might be interested in supporting early childhood development and outdoor education—we would be incredibly grateful. Every donation helps bring us one step closer to our goal. If you'd like to make a donation or get involved, please don't hesitate to reach out directly.
