

**POSITION:** Sunday School Coordinator (10hrs a week)  
**ACCOUNTABLE TO:** Christ as the Head of the Church, Senior Pastor of Peace.  
**PURPOSE:** To facilitate a home centered, church supported Sunday morning ministry to children.

**PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Select, Order and Prepare curriculum for the Sunday School Year.
- Recruit and Train Sunday School Teachers and Support Staff.
- Meet Monthly with the Sr. Pastor for Support and Report.
- Collect needed supplies for teachers.
- Print lessons and distribute to teachers.
- Provide ongoing support and coordination with teachers.
- Record and Report Sunday School attendance weekly.
- Unlock doors in preschool wing and make sure rooms are clean after class
- Develop and recruit a substitute list for existing Sunday School Teachers.
- Lead a Children's Lesson in church one Sunday every six weeks.
- Handle issues for teachers as they come up during class time.

**KEY AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY:**

- Align Peace's ministry to children with the overall Mission/Vision and objectives of the congregation.
- Provide Leadership, Organization and Support for the Sunday School Ministry, as to best care for the families of Peace as we partner with them in the raising of their children in the Lord.
- Keep the Sunday School ministry strong, stable and on track until we call/hire a Director of Family Life at Peace.

**REQUIRED SKILLS AND ATTRIBUTES:**

- Strong Organizational Skills
- Relational and able to work with others.
- A Self-Driver.
- A commitment to the Lords Work, His church at Peace and ministry to children.
