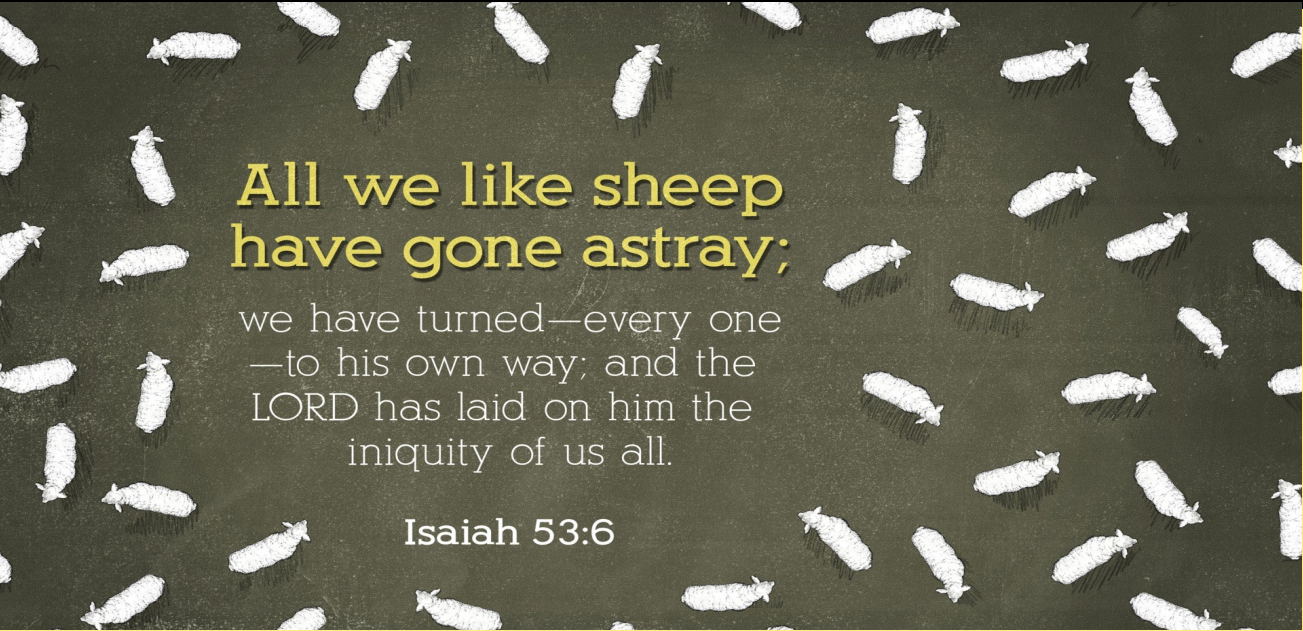

**The Wise and Foolish Builders**

Jesus wraps up His Sermon on the Mount with this teaching. Anyone who hears Jesus' words and actually DOES them is like a wise man who built his house on a solid foundation of rock. When a storm raged, that house stood strong. But people who hear Jesus' words and don't follow through are like a foolish man who slaps together a home on the sand—one that collapses when the wind comes. Truly hearing from God means putting what you hear into action. Kids can be confident that God does speak to them because, as we read in John 10:27- 28, Jesus is the good shepherd and we are His sheep. And a sheep KNOWS the shepherd's voice. [BOTTOM LINE] Practice hearing from God.

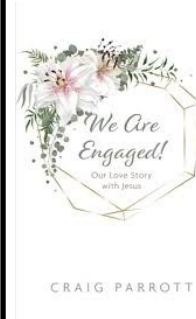

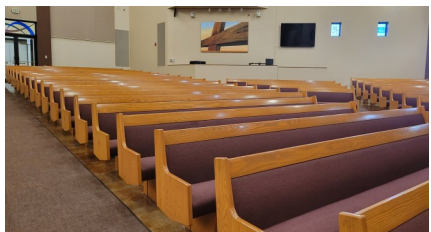
