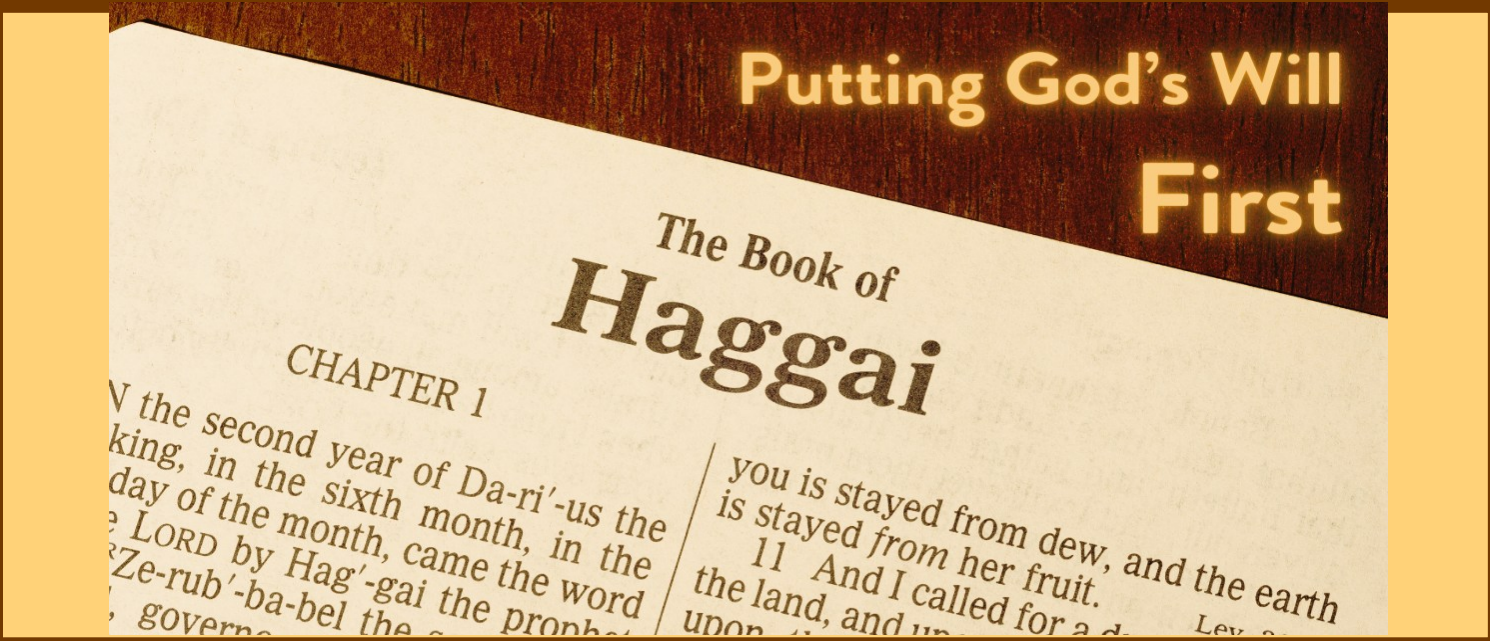

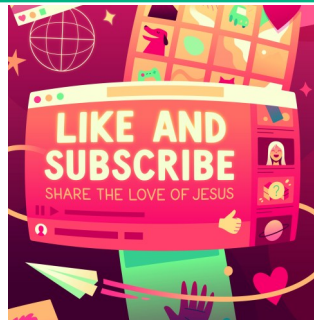

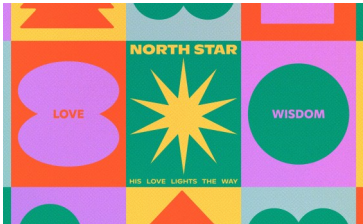

The Lost Sheep Jesus tells a story about a shepherd who has 100 sheep ... until he loses one. The shepherd leaves the 99 and searches until he finds the lost one. Then he joyfully carries it home and celebrates. Jesus tells this story to show that He loves everyone like the shepherd loves his sheep. He sees us—no matter where we are or what we've done—and He seeks us out to bring us close to Him.

The Most Important Commandment
During Week 2, we explore the Most Important Commandment. Several religious leaders try to trap Jesus with a trick question: basically, choose your top commandment so everyone can take you down for picking the wrong one. Just how many rules are we talking here? We revisit the original Ten Commandments in Exodus, as well as the additional 603 laws and the extras added around them by the religious leaders. Instead of debating, Jesus rolls them all into two simple commands. [BOTTOM LINE] Love God. Love others.

- **Holy Communion:** As Lutheran Christians, we believe, teach and confess that the risen Lord Jesus Christ is actually present in the Sacrament of Holy Communion. He gives us His true body and blood in, with and under the bread and wine for the forgiveness of our sins. This teaching of the real presence of Christ is central to our celebration of this sacrament. Therefore, we practice fellowship or close communion—meaning we believe those approaching the altar should share this core belief. Grape juice is available in the center cup of the tray. Library: *Somehow it has always been easier for people to believe in demons than in the brighter side of the unseen world – the world of God's protecting angels.* **Angels** by Billy Graham is a thoughtful & faith-centered exploration of what the Bible teaches about angels & their role in God's plan. Graham combines Scripture, personal stories, and historical references to explain how angels serve as messengers, protectors, and guides for believers. His writing is clear and accessible, making complex spiritual ideas easy to understand for readers at any stage of faith. The book encourages readers to recognize God's presence & care through these unseen beings. Rather than focusing on speculation, Graham emphasizes biblical truth & spiritual growth. Overall, *Angels* is an inspiring and reassuring read for those interested in deepening their understanding of the spiritual world.
