

- **Holy Communion:** As Lutheran Christians, we believe, teach and confess that the risen Lord Jesus Christ is actually present in the Sacrament of Holy Communion. He gives us His true body and blood in, with and under the bread and wine for the forgiveness of our sins. This teaching of the real presence of Christ is central to our celebration of this sacrament. Therefore, we practice fellowship or close communion—meaning we believe those approaching the altar should share this core belief. Grape juice is available in the center cup of the tray. Gluten free wafers also available.

**Library: 103 Questions Children Ask about Right from Wrong** (241.07 One) is a faith-based guide that helps children understand moral choices through clear, age-appropriate answers rooted in the Bible. The book addresses common questions about honesty, kindness, obedience, and responsibility, using Scripture to explain why these values matter. Each response is designed to be easy for children to understand while encouraging them to think about how their actions affect others. It also helps parents and teachers start meaningful conversations about character and faith. Overall, the book emphasizes living according to God's Word as the foundation for making wise and loving decisions.
