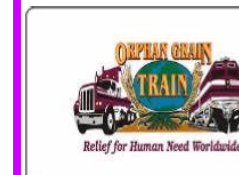

Other requirements are bathrooms, water access, electrical outlets, and trash receptacles, with a rental fee of up to \$600/month.
