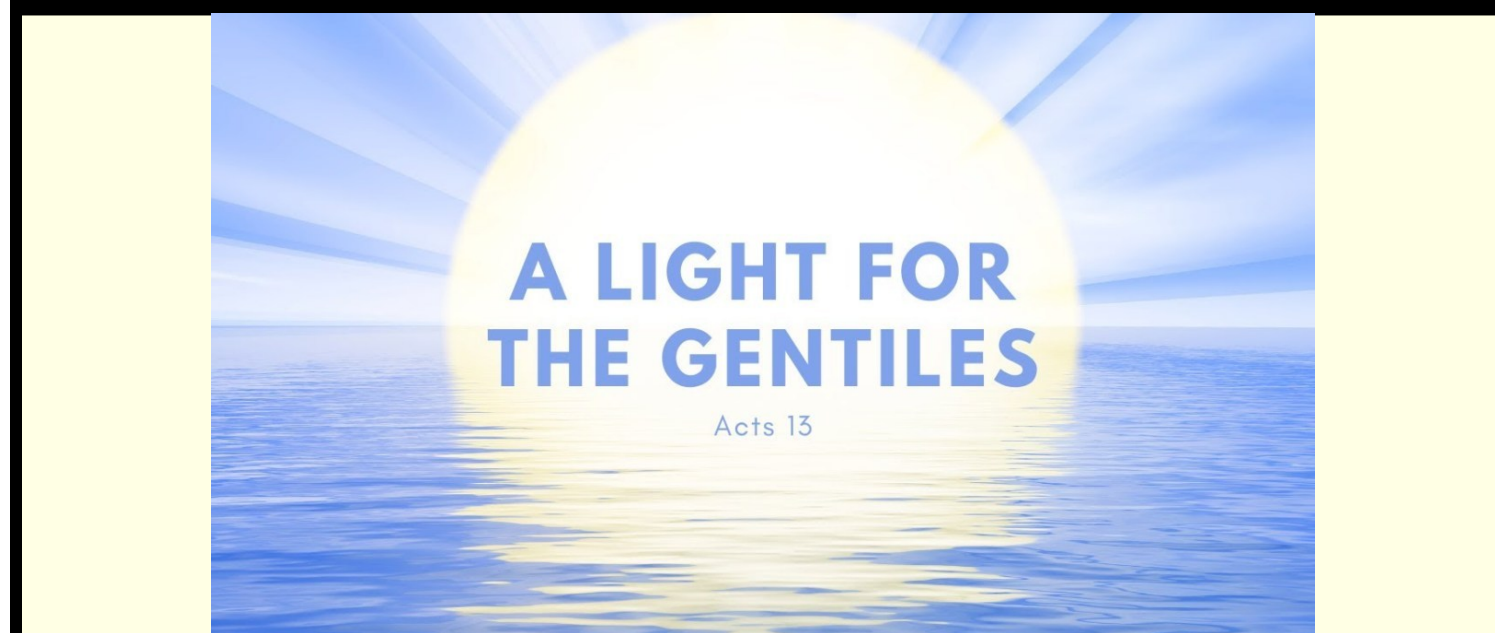

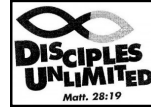

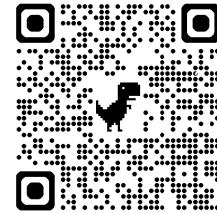

**Orphan Grain Train** is in need of a facility for collecting donations. The approximate perimeters for this facility should be between Colfax to 144<sup>th</sup> and York to Indiana, about mid-May. The most important requirements are at least 1400 square feet of space, that is heated/cooled, on one level, and has parking access for receiving and loading packed boxes and other equipment. Other requirements are bathrooms, water access, electrical outlets, and trash receptacles, with a rental fee of up to \$600/month.
