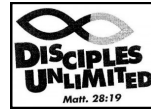

**Library Of Love and Treason** by Jamie Ogle (F Ogl) is a historical romance novel set in 3rd century Rome, where Valentine, a pillar of faith and Christian martyr, secretly performs Christian marriages in defiance of an imperial ban while also leading a group of believers. Meanwhile, Iris, the daughter of a Roman jailor, seeks healing for her blindness and is drawn into Valentine's world, where she discovers faith and hope. As their relationship deepens, they face growing danger from the Roman empire. The story as presented by Ogle is a beautiful depiction of what Christ does for His church. Ultimately, the story explores love, sacrifice, and trusting God even amid suffering and uncertainty. This novel won the 2024 Christy Award for historical romance.
