**Lutheran Hour Ministries Overseas**

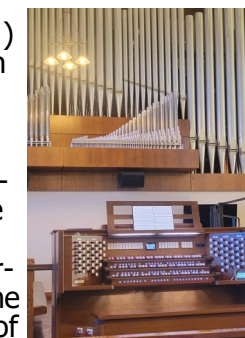

**Organ Donations** (not what you think!)

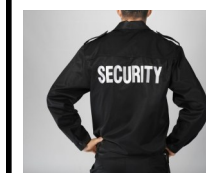
