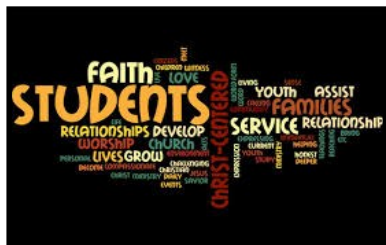

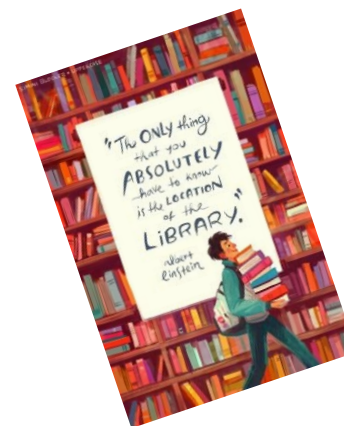

Library: SAIL INTO SUMMER
 The **Murphy Shepherd Series** (F Mar) is a bestselling four-book series for young adults. All follow the trials of Murphy, and all are riveting stories of heroism, heartache, and the power of love. Murphy is a solitary man. He keeps his history and his secrets to himself. But when vulnerable people go missing, he is the man to call. He has devoted his life to finding survivors of human trafficking.

The Water Keeper. Murphy lives alone on an island, tending the grounds of a church with no parishioners. In this first book, Murphy searches for a lost daughter along Florida's Intercoastal Waterway.

The Letter Keeper. Once again, Murphy finds himself in a desperate search, but this time, the nightmare strikes too close to home when his new wife, her daughter, and two other teenage girls are taken. With more dead ends than leads, he has no idea how to find them. Hope feels lost, but Murphy is willing to risk everything to bring them home.

The Record Keeper. Murphy's last rescue mission nearly cost him his life. He would like nothing more than to stay close to his wife and daughters for a while. But his best friend and mentor is taken, and Murphy faces his most dangerous challenge yet.

The Keeper. Devastated by personal loss, Murphy is not sure he can continue his life's work. But he has no choice. He must jump back in when the current US Vice Presidents' three daughters are grabbed, bound and blindfolded from their home. Only Murphy and his team have any chance of finding them.
