• **Holy Communion:** As Lutheran Christians, we believe, teach and confess that the risen Lord Jesus Christ is actually present in the Sacrament of Holy Communion. He gives us His true body and blood in, with and under the bread and wine for the forgiveness of our sins. This teaching of the real presence of Christ is central to our celebration of this sacrament. Therefore, we practice fellowship or close communion—meaning we believe those approaching the altar should share this core belief. Grape juice is available in the center cup of the tray. Gluten free wafers also available. *If you are unable to come forward for communion, please raise your hand to get an ushers attention. An elder will bring it to you in your seat.* Please speak with a pastor or elder if you have questions.

Library: SAIL INTO SUMMER

Kids, if you want a great book to read on your way to another prize in the library glass case, try one of these books in *Liberty Letters: Adventures in Jamestown* by

Nancy LeSourd, historical fiction for readers aged 8-12 **Y LesV.1**, tells the story of two best friends, Abigail and Elizabeth, whose lives take different paths in the early 1600s. Abigail travels with her family to Jamestown, beginning with a dangerous voyage and then continues with the harsh realities of starvation and struggles to survive in the New World. A chance meeting and unexpected friendship with Pocahontas challenges Abigail in ways only her faith can make sense of. Elizabeth remains in England, where she faces society's expectations for young women while longing to learn and pursue her own dreams. Through letters between the two friends, the story explores friendship, loss, fear, courage, faith, forgiveness and the choices that shaped the destiny of America.

This book is the first in the series, with *Liberty Letters: Escape on the Underground Railroad* being the next book. Look for them both in the Peace Library!
