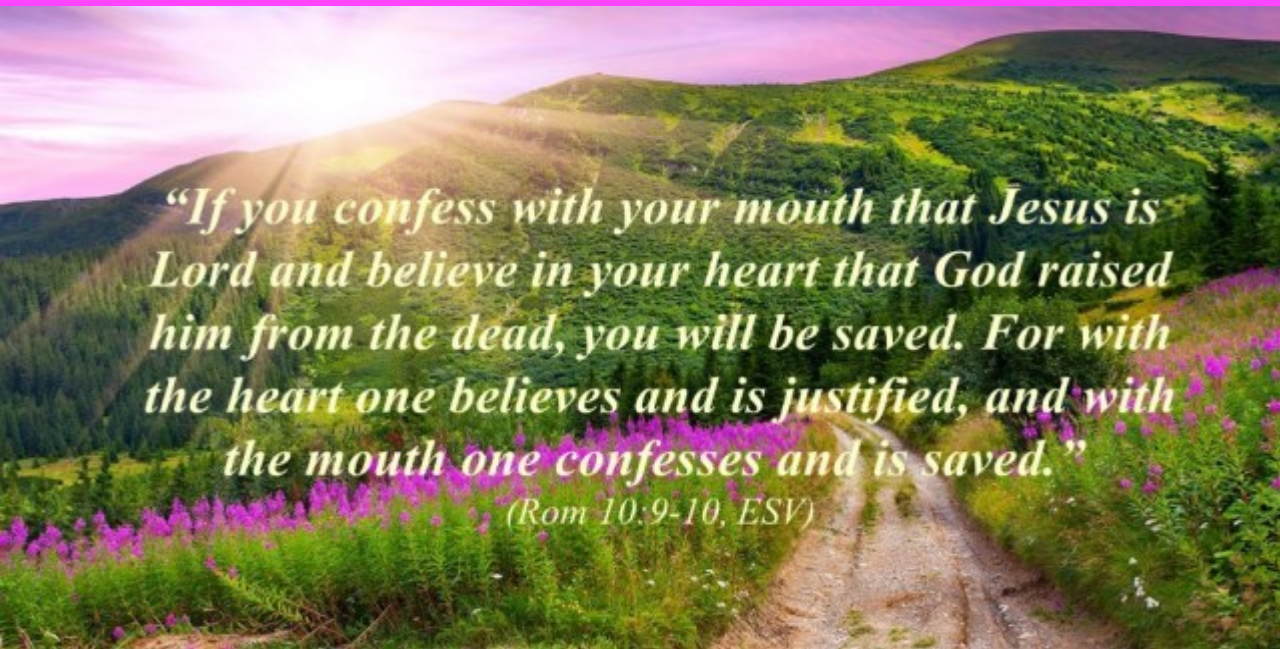

• **Holy Communion:** As Lutheran Christians, we believe, teach and confess that the risen Lord Jesus Christ is actually present in the Sacrament of Holy Communion. He gives us His true body and blood in, with and under the bread and wine for the forgiveness of our sins. This teaching of the real presence of Christ is central to our celebration of this sacrament. Therefore, we practice fellowship or close communion—meaning we believe those approaching the altar should share this core belief. Grape juice is available in the center cup of the tray. Gluten free wafers also available. *If you are unable to come forward for communion, please raise your hand to get an ushers attention. An elder will bring it to you in your seat.* Please speak with a pastor or elder if you have questions.

Library A modern teen is transported to 14th-century Italy, caught in a battle between knights, and rescued by a dashing prince. Wow! What could be better? *Waterfall* by Lisa T. Bergren (Y Ber V.1) tells the story of the Bentarrini sisters who have spent every summer of their lives with their archeologist parents, among the romantic hills of Italy. Both Gabi and her sister Lia are bored out of their minds until Gabi places her hand atop a handprint in an ancient tomb and finds herself in 14th-century Italy. Their summer has just gotten a whole lot more interesting! In her new surroundings, she discovers a new sense of purpose and identity, the strong ties of family, and that finding true courage comes from trusting God rather than relying on her own strength. This inspiring blend of historical fiction and Christian values encourages readers to trust God's plan even when the future is unclear.
