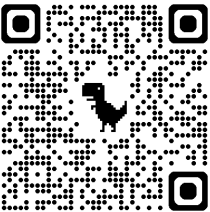

- **Holy Communion:** As Lutheran Christians, we believe, teach and confess that the risen Lord Jesus Christ is actually present in the Sacrament of Holy Communion. He gives us His true body and blood in, with and under the bread and wine for the forgiveness of our sins. This teaching of the real presence of Christ is central to our celebration of this sacrament. Therefore, we practice fellowship or close communion—meaning we believe those approaching the altar should share this core belief. Grape juice is available in the center cup of the tray. Gluten free wafers also available. *If you are unable to come forward for communion, please raise your hand to get an ushers attention. An elder will bring it to you in your seat.* Please speak with a pastor or elder if you have questions.

**Library: A Man of Heroic Endurance - JOB**, by Charles Swindoll (221.9 Swi), is a book that we all should read. Why? Because as we know, life can be hard. Here Swindoll masterfully examines the story of Job to teach us about faith, suffering, and human endurance. Swindoll argues that Job was not weak or passive. Instead, Job's endurance and quiet strength through many trials were true acts of heroism. Swindoll also includes stories of people, both famous and unknown, who have endured tremendous trials. In the dedication, Swindoll writes, "This book is dedicated to all in the family of God who are going through times of great suffering and have been devastated by the pain you have had to endure ...Like Job you keep praying and waiting ... Like Job you wonder where God is ... He remains silent ... Nevertheless, you faithfully endure ... Because of that, like Job, someday you will be rewarded."
